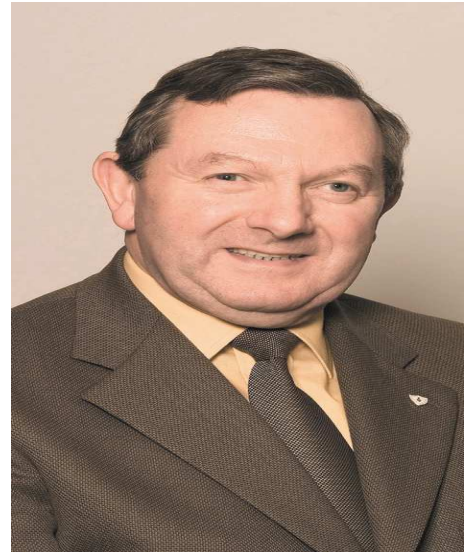

A **youth club** is a safe accessible place where young people can meet with their peers and be given the opportunity to participate in activities and programmes organised by themselves or by their leaders.

Many youth clubs are set up to provide young people within a specific area with a social outlet, where they can take full advantage of participating in recreational activities or non-formal youth work programmes. Some clubs are designed to simply keep young people off the streets, enabling them to take an interest in an activity and fostering their personal development. Other youth clubs can have a particular compelling force or interest, such as music or faith. Whichever youth club a young person finds themselves drawn too, the benefits of their interaction within that club can be enormous.

**Youth Work** is defined in our Youth Work Act 2001 is “A planned programme of education designed for the purpose of aiding and enhancing the personal and social development of young people through their voluntary participation, which is complimentary to their formal, academic or vocational education and training and provided primarily by voluntary youth organisations.” The Act defines a young person, as someone under 25 years but requires a particular focus on those aged between 10 and 21.

## **Classification of Youth Organisations in Co. Cavan**

### **Community and Independent Youth Groups**

These youth groups are not linked to, or affiliated to, any local or national organisation. Usually they operate in one specific community area and are run by volunteers, who have an interest in youth service provision. They have their own voluntary committee, constitution, financial procedures and plan their own programme of activities on a regular basis.

### **Community Games**

Co Cavan Community Games is divided up into 19 areas throughout the county with children entering and competing in numerous sporting and youth events at County, Ulster and National Level every year. Each area has its own committee usually made up of a number of volunteers who offer their time to support the organisation in their activities.

### **Foróige**

Foroige is a national youth development organisation that lends its ethos, constitution and policies to local community based youth groups. The young people elect their own youth committee that manage and operates the club in co-operation with adult voluntary leaders. Each club plan their own programme of activities.

### **Macra na Feirme**

Macra na Feirme is a national youth development organisation for young people aged between 17-35 years. A voluntary led youth group, this organisations popularity lies predominantly in rural communities. Macra's activities central around their five key aims of travel, sport, performing arts, public speaking and farming.

### **Paid Staff Youth Clubs or Groups**

Paid staff youth clubs or groups are usually co-funded or mainstream funded youth projects that have dedicated youth personnel working with young people on informal programmes of activities. Normally, these projects are issued based in nature and can regularly be found in areas of disadvantage.

### **Pioneers Total Abstinence Association (PTAA) Youth Groups**

The Pioneer Movement was founded by Fr. James Cullen in 1898 to address the problem of Alcohol abuse which was rampant in Irish society at that time. Pioneer youth groups are voluntary run social outlets for young people who are members of the PTAA and abstain from alcohol and illegal substances.

### **Religious Based Youth Groups:**

Religious based youth groups offer young people the opportunity to be part of a group which empowers and supports their spiritual and religious development.

- **The Boys Brigade** seeks to advance Christ's kingdom among boys and the promotion of habits of obedience, reverence, discipline, self-respect and all that tends towards a true Christian manliness.
- **The Girls Friendly Society** is a Christian international and interdenominational organisation, seeking to develop girls spiritually, physically and educationally. A comprehensive programme is organised under these three headings.

### **Uniform Youth Organisations:**

Uniform youth organisations are so called because participants wear a uniform whilst participating in activities. The uniform identifies the wearer with their own particular age group and the range of activities that they can participate in.

- **Scouting Ireland** is a voluntary, non-formal educational movement. The aim of scouts is to encourage the physical, intellectual, emotional, social and spiritual development of young people so that they may achieve their full potential and, as responsible citizens, improve society.

- **The Girl Guides** are a voluntary, non-formal group that enable girls and young women to develop to their fullest potential as responsible citizens of the world.

### **Youth Bands**

Youth Bands offer young people the opportunity to learn how to play musical instruments and read music. Young people can discover their musical talents, developing skills and availing of the opportunity to participate in public performances with their peers. They encourage group work, promote good citizenship and respect for music and others.
